Article XIX
General Provisions

~~Section 19.04 Expenses. The actual and necessary expenses of all legislators, officers and employees paid from county funds incurred in the performance of powers and duties of the county shall be a county charge.~~

~~The county legislature may by resolution authorize the payment of a mileage allowance as fixed by said legislature for the expense of using an automobile privately owned by the user thereof and operated by any legislator, officer or employee.~~

~~Whenever under the charter or this code, the appointment of a board or commission by whatever title known, is authorized, the actual and necessary expenses including mileage incurred in the performance of their duties shall be a county charge.~~

County legislators, officers and employees are not necessarily entitled to reimbursement. The county legislature may approve annually a resolution allowing for the payment of expenses, including mileage incurred in the performance of powers and duties of the county. The determination of the legislature shall clearly indicate each expense to be reimbursed and the rate to be paid for using an automobile privately owned in the performance of powers and duties of the county. No legislator, officer or employee shall be reimbursed expenses or mileage that is not clearly indicated in the annual resolution approved by the legislature, except by an additional resolution approved by the legislature.
